## *The Vision...*

---

Jack Miller, founding pastor of New Life Glenside, said that our goal in disciple making is "...to produce disciples so wrought upon by the message of the cross that it becomes apparent to all that these people have a life that is crucified, where the will has been given to Christ, where the mind has been given to Christ, where the emotions have been given to Christ, where Christ has so entered their lives that others must say, 'They are Christlike.'"

Passion for Christ does not come without some struggle. Francis Schaeffer said the biggest problem in Christianity today is that we do the work of God by flesh rather than by faith. Self-reliance personifies American culture and American evangelicals. The result is that anxiety, discouragement, and frustration characterize the lives of many Christians in our day. When they are engaged in advancing the kingdom in a dramatic way, burnout, dropout, and retreat often result. The evangelical church today is full of believers who have become satisfied with being spectators in the kingdom expansion.

Living for the King is designed to promote the kind of discipleship that Jack Miller taught. The goal of the course is to equip the members of our congregation for kingdom discipleship. This involves following Jesus more thoroughly and bringing the message of Christ to those who have not yet heard it. Many members of New Life and other local congregations have experienced the liberating power of the gospel through World Harvest Mission's Sonship program. Living for the King is modeled after this Sonship material.

## *Sonship: Grounded in Grace*

---

The focus of Sonship is to liberate you for service to God and love of others by experiencing God's love afresh. As you learn more about what it means to be justified by faith and adopted as a child of God, you will develop a new identity. The goal of the Sonship track is to see your self-image defined by God's view of you, not by the opinions of others or by your own success or failure. Once a foundation of belief is laid, we bring the message of the Gospel to bear in important areas and issues that affect our daily lives. The Gospel is the unifying theme and provides the basis for growth in Christ-like character because we believe that discipleship is a growth process, fueled by grace. Discipleship is learning how to understand your gifts and calling in light of God's kingdom purposes. Our goal is to help every individual develop a personal plan for Christian growth and service. Paul's letters to the Galatians and the Romans form the core message for this track. In the memory work, special emphasis is laid on meditation and rebuilding your thought patterns so these truths become second nature to you.

Everything in the program is designed to promote your transformation.

### TIME COMMITMENT AND COST

The course is 18 weeks and begins **September 27th, 2010 through Feb 21st, 2010**, and one Saturday morning prayer time.

The course will meet on **Monday evenings from 7:15 to 9:00 pm**. The meetings combine large group teaching with small group discussion and application. Some additional time will be needed each week for Scripture memory, reading assignments and discipleship activities.

We meet in room 306 at our building, 2015 S. Limekiln Pike, Dresher, Pennsylvania.
