

## **Women's Bible Study**

### **Genesis 19**

1. Re-read Genesis 18:20-21. What does God say is the reason he judges a city? (Who do you think is doing the “outcry”?)

2. What hints does the narrator immediately give us about the condition of Sodom? What does Lot's seat in the gate tell us about his position and influence in the city?

3. Trace the ways that God (through the angels) seeks to save Lot and how Lot and his family respond to each effort. What do we learn here about how God works in our lives?

4. In what ways are you like Lot? How has your judgment become clouded by voices other than the Lord's? Where are you hesitant to be different in the surrounding culture? How does 1 Peter 2:9-12 encourage you?

5. How do verses 30-38 depict the degree to which Lot's whole family was influenced by their surrounding culture? Why do you think this passage is in the Bible?
